Dear Parents,

Just a brief note to tie up a few loose ends and bring the year to a close.

MEDICAL UPDATE: Several boarders are due for a booster dose of their typhoid vaccine. Notes have been sent to each parent concerned to ensure that the shot is given to their sons in Feb 2002. Parents are also requested to ensure that all the other necessary vaccines are given to their children on schedule. This year we had one case of jaundice and two cases of typhoid — all of which could have been prevented by taking the necessary precautions.

BOOKLISTS: The book list for the books needed for the new academic year have been posted along with the results. As in previous years the books can be purchased either directly by you or by contacting Mr Thakker in Mt Abu. The advantage of contacting Mr Thakker is that the books will be supplied to your son in school next year — and the bother of transporting the books to Mt Abu can be avoided.
